The aforementioned Charis Camp is a good example. Our desire is to produce testimonials from 3 minutes to 30 minutes in length which can be shown in various social media platforms, especially the highly successful Life Stories Worldwide which has

reached millions of people. GNTV Chairman Steve Chamberlain of Regina has received the necessary equipment (cost \$3403) for video production and is putting together a team for editing, etc. I encourage all FGBM in the Regina vicinity to start preparing testimonials of 3, 5, 10 and 30 minutes to get Steve started.
