Our doctrinal statement is not a "creed". In a sense, the whole Bible is our creed. We recognize the existence of many differences in interpretation among genuine Christians. We are, however, convinced that to avoid a looseness which might result in the admission of unbelievers into our Fellowship, or even of Christians who are unprepared to co-operate in the Fellowship and the work to which God has called us, certain minimum Biblical doctrinal standards must be established, the rejection of any of which shall be grounds for ineligibility to membership.
